At the outbreak of the First World War on the 4th August 1914, the 'Chorley Terriers' - D Company, 1st / 4th (TF) Battalion, Loyal North Lancashire Regiment were at their annual camp at Kirkby Lonsdale. They were recalled and put on a war footing. Two days later, on the 6th August, over 200 men marched from the Drill Hall on Devonshire Road in Chorley to Preston; many of their relatives walked with them along the A6, as far as the boundary with Whittle-le-Woods.

Since 2010, the **CHORLEY** REMEMBERS project has played its part in remembering the fallen from the town - adding names to the Chorley War Memorial in Astley Park and restoring the adjacent Memorial Arch. They also opened the 'Remembrance Experience' exhibition in the Coach House on the Astley Hall complex. We would like to continue our work by enhancing the exhibition, as well as staging a number of events to commemorate the start of the First World War. I intend to replicate the walk on the 6th August this year, and ask you to sponsor me to do the ten miles.
